

Farmer's Elevator of Honeyford

Bergstrom Electric has been providing electrical contracting services to the Farmer's Elevator of Honeyford for many years. Included on the list of projects are:

- The 2007 Elevator Expansion, which included 3 new grain tanks and a conveyor system so they could load 100-car unit trains. It also included integrated touch screen Motor Control Centers at several different locations within the facility. This design-build project was completed in November of 2007 and cost approximately \$200,000. It took Bergstrom crews 1582 man-hours to complete the job.
- The 2010 Elevator Expansion was completed in November of that year and included an unloading pit, a new 78 foot diameter grain tank, conveying systems from the existing tanks to the new tank, an addition to the integrated touch screen control system so that employees can start and stop all the new motors from three different locations, and a

new electrical room with 1200 amp/480 volt service to power the new components. The project cost approximately \$214,000 and took 1526 man-hours to complete.

In addition to these large projects, Bergstrom's Service Department, headed up by Jason Wardner, has had a long-standing relationship with the Honeyford Elevator, completing numerous smaller projects and repair jobs for the facility over the years. Some of the more recent, smaller projects have included:

- the addition of a grain dryer
- an office addition
- the addition of a new scale
- a new sampling probe

Bergstrom Electric continues to provide electrical contracting service to the Farmer's Elevator of Honeyford on an as-needed basis.



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
